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Invitation to Participate Student Civility Program

I, the undersigned, have agreed to attend the sanctioned Student Civility Program (SCP) learning modules, which meet on a weekly basis and may require up to 90-minutes each for successful completion. The SCP Coordinator will document and notify the referral source of any grievances related to the student’s participation in this program. The SCP Coordinator will send an official letter of completion once the student has satisfied the participation requirements documented above.

Confidentiality

The SCP Coordinator is responsible for protecting student confidentiality by restricting disclosure of information contained in the student’s education records as defined by the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA). These records will only be released after receiving written consent by the student themselves (if over 18); by court order; or, for legitimate educational interests.

The SCP Coordinator has an obligation to report any incidence of sexual assault that has occurred on or off-campus and involved any member of the university community (i.e., faculty, staff, students, student employees, graduate associates, etc.)

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
